Day 5: Journey to the Porcelain Capital — Awakening the Kiln Within

Leave Shanghai's modern skyline behind and travel to Jingdezhen, the sacred home of porcelain.

In the evening, an ancient pit-firing ceremony ignites creative energy. Around the fire, clay and flame merge in a raw, elemental celebration of art. Paired with traditional clay-oven roasted chicken, the evening becomes both a cultural and sensory feast.

Day 6: Immersing in the Porcelain Capital — Creativity Unleashed

At the Imperial Kiln Museum, experience the grandeur and legacy of royal porcelain culture.

In the afternoon, participate in the "Colorful Flow" workshop and let your creativity move freely through clay and glaze.

As night falls, Taoxichuan comes alive, offering opportunities to engage with international artists and contemporary ceramic practices.

Day 7: Meeting the Masters — The Voice of Craft

Morning: Visit Yaoli Ancient Town, a peaceful landscape regarded as the "source of porcelain," surrounded by mountains and clear waters.

Afternoon: Meet National Intangible Cultural Heritage master Zhan Shaolin and a doctoral supervisor from Jingdezhen Ceramic University. In their studios, craftsmanship becomes more than technique—it becomes a lifelong devotion to art.

Day 8: Living Heritage — The World of Porcelain

At the Ancient Kiln Folk Culture Exhibition Area, witness artisans shaping clay into timeless vessels using traditional methods. This is not only observation, but a deep connection with living history.

Afternoon: Attend the Jingdezhen International Ceramics Fair, where outstanding works from around the world come together, revealing the limitless possibilities of contemporary ceramics.

Day 9: Autumn Encounters — The Beauty of Huizhou

Travel to Huangling in Wuyuan, home to the iconic “drying the harvest” scene. Rooftops become canvases of red peppers, golden corn, and autumn abundance—like a living painting.

At night, in Wunüzhou, witness the spectacular intangible heritage performance of molten iron fireworks. In that moment, fire, artistry, and emotion converge in the sky.

Day 10: Wandering Sanqing — Inside a Living Ink Painting

Spend the day immersed in the dreamlike landscape of Sanqing Mountain. Peaks rise through drifting mist like brushstrokes in a traditional ink painting.

Here, nature becomes art, offering space for reflection and creative inspiration.

Day 11: A Celestial Dream — Lanterns of Gexian Village

In Gexian Village, time slows. As night falls, thousands of lanterns illuminate the valley, transforming the village into a dreamlike world.

Wander through Lingbao Immortal Street in traditional Hanfu, and experience a poetic, almost otherworldly atmosphere.

Return to Jingdezhen and explore the vibrant Sculpture Porcelain Factory market, discovering unique handmade pieces and local ceramic culture.
